- (1) personal data on the nominee that includes:
 - 1. Name in Full
 - 2. Address
 - 3. Present Position or Occupation
 - 4. Academic Training (institution, degree, year, major field)
 - 5. Professional Record (including special honors)
 - 6. Membership in other Scientific Organizations
 - 7. List of Publications do not list abstracts, book reviews, or papers which have not yet been accepted for publication.
- (2) the sponsor's nomination statement that includes:
 - 1. an indication of the length and nature of your acquaintance with the candidate
 - 2. the nominee's research contributions to the field to date
 - 3. the nominee's meritorious educational contributions to the field
 - 4. your evaluation of his/her scientific ability or impact on the field over the course of his/her career
 - 5. your name, affiliation, address, and contact information.
- (3) write a brief statement (75-100 words) summarizing the key features of the nomination, which will be the basis of the congratulatory letter and a press release for their home institution.
- *(4) Co-sponsors are no longer required for a fellowship nomination, but can be included if arranged for by the sponsor. Letters from co-sponsors can help a nomination, especially of younger or lesser known individuals. There should be no more than two co-sponsors and their statements should include the same information requested from the sponsor described in (2). Co-sponsors need not be MSA members or fellows.

Nominations can be carried over to following years if the nomination package is updated by the sponsor. Any nomination not renewed after 2 years will be not considered further.
